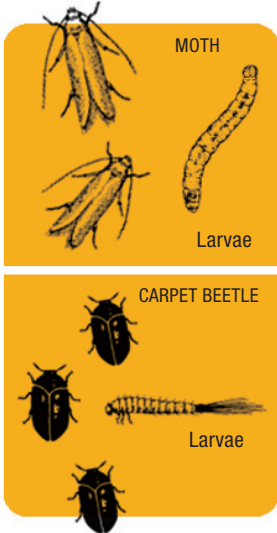

MOTH PREVENTION FACTS



Moths A single moth can lay up to 300 eggs throughout the year. The destructive larvae emerging from these eggs are cream colored and grow up to 1/2" in length. During this stage the larvae feed on wool, fur and other animal and natural fibers. The larvae have also been known to damage non-organic materials as well but this is incidental to feeding on nearby organic fabrics. The larvae stage lasts 60-90 days. The adult moth is about 3/8" long and the wing color is beige and lives an average of 4-6 days. Moths can reproduce year round in temperatures above 50° F.

Carpet Beetles Adult Carpet Beetles are a dull black color and about 1/8" to 3/16" long. The larvae are hairy, tan and have white stripes. It is the larvae stage of the carpet beetle that causes damage to carpeting, clothing, fur and animal hides. The larvae may also be found around milled food products. The accumulation of pet hair provides a common food source for the larvae. They breed and feed outdoors in such places as bird and rodent nests but also may fly or crawl into homes where breeding and feeding may take place. Carpet Beetles can cause considerable damage since they eat in both the larvae and adult stages.

Flat Storage

Moth Balls, crystals, nuggets and sachets provide protection for articles stored in trunks, drawers, boxes etc. They should be sprinkled or placed on the bottom of the storage space, between the folds and layers of clothes and on top before securely closing the container.

Hanging Storage

Moth blocks should be used to protect clothes stored in closets. Moth cakes are ideal for protecting clothes stored in garment bags. Hanging the moth preventive above the the stored items will allow for the vapors to travel downward and penetrate the articles. Enoz moth preventive can also be used to protect clothes against mildew. Following the same directions for moth prevention can help to prevent costly mildew damage.

Remember these helpful hints:

- Have clothes cleaned prior to storage.
- Use only recommended plastic storage containers (do not use cleaning bags, plastic garbage bags, etc).
- Do not mix chemicals.
- Read and follow directions carefully.
- See individual packages for complete directions and dosages.
- Control moisture in your home.
